**RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF OYO STATE AUDIT LAW 2021:
ESTABLISHMENT OF AUDIT SERVICE COMMISSION**

Further to Circular Letter No. SSG/W2021/Audit /Com/30 dated 31st July, 2021, I wish to inform you that some Sections of Oyo State Audit Commission Law Year 2021 have been amended.

2. The amended Sections are, Section 22, Section 24, Section 26 and Section 38. Therefore, the State Civil Service Commission and all other relevant stakeholders are to take note of these amendments for appointment of Auditors-General (State and Local Governments).
3. In the circumstance, all Ministries, Department and Agencies of the State Government, including Tertiary Institutions and Local Government Areas, are to

be guided by the legislation on the appointment, operational and financial autonomy of the offices of the Auditor-General for State and the Auditor-General for Local Governments and work in accordance with this development in ensuring proper accountability and transparency.

4. Finally, all persons and entities in the State, engaged in the receipt or use of public funds and resources are also required to be fully conversant with the legislation and to take all measures necessary to ensure full compliance.
